I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 2 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Treatment during this year also brought out International Conference on Neurological Disorders, which consisted of ~2 abstracts.

Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Treatment factor of Journal of Renal Medicine for the year 2018 was 0.51, while the current SJR index dropped to 0.156.

During the calendar year 2019, Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Treatment received a total of 20 papers, out of which 15 articles (58%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 2 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the issue 1 of Volume 2 published during the year 2019, a total of 1 article were published of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 60 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 1 article published in volume 2. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 12 Editors, 20 Reviewers joined the board Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Treatment and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Enna Adapa during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Natalia Jones in bringing out issues of Neurodevelopmental Disorders and Treatment in time.
